RACE 1	
LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN, 350m	
3 Spring Tesla	A post-race urine sample was obtained.
5 Jumby's Soldier	Making the first turn appeared to gallop awkwardly within its action and lost ground. Entering the turn into the home straight ran extremely wide when shifting off heels and lost momentum. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent injury.
7 Meehni Soldier	Midway down the home straight appeared to momentarily look inwardly towards Kodiak Bear (6). Stewards spoke to trainer Ms Chloe Bilal regarding the greyhound actions during the home straight. Stewards took no further action. In electing not to pursue further action, Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied that a breach of the rules had occurred to such an extent to pursue any further action.

LADBROKES RACING CLUB MAIDEN, 350m	
4 Denali Bear	A post-race urine sample was obtained.
6 Wimlah Soldier	Making the first turn was crowded for room before a short distance later became badly unbalanced when colliding heavily with another runner, knuckling over and lost ground. Thereafter, galloped awkwardly for the remainder of the event and finished a long distance behind the field. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a nearside fore carpal strain. A 21-day incapacitation period was issued.

LADBROKES BLACKBOOK MAIDEN, 440m

2 Timor	Making the turn out of the back straight was steadied at heels before a short distance later made contact with the running rail and lost momentum. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent injury.
7 Balmoral Queen	Immediately after box rise turned its head and shifted inwardly before straightening up. After reviewing all available video footage, Stewards were comfortably satisfied Balmoral Queen (7) was looking inwardly towards the lure. No further action was taken.

Prior to the declaration of 'All Clear', the Stewards observed a bird which had flown onto the outside grass area midway down the home straight during the race before flying off as the greyhounds approached. After reviewing all available video footage, Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no greyhounds were materially prejudiced or affected by this occurring. As such, the Stewards gave 'All Clear'.	
7 Bikini Riot	Making the first turn was crowded for room before shortly after was obliged to check off heels, becoming unbalanced and lost ground.

RACE 10	
GOULBURN GREYHOUNDS AS PETS, 350m	
2 Polly Wilson	Making the first turn was tightened for room and lost ground. Midway between the first turn and the home turn came together with another runner, becoming badly and lost further ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed offside pin muscle, hip support, nearside back and lower back muscle soreness A 28-day incapacitation period was issued. After consultation with the on-track veterinarian, Stewards have issued a direction to trainer Mr Raymond Stevenson advising him that before Polly Wilson (2) is able to nominate again for future racing, it must undertake a full veterinary examination by GWIC to confirm the greyhound is fit to start in accordance with GAR19(3)(w).
4 Bandit Bluey	Began as a heavily supported short-priced favourite. Making the first turn was tightened for room and lost momentum. Midway between the first turn and the home turn came together with another runner and lost further momentum.

RACE 11

LABROKES ODDS SURGE, 350m

The commencement of Race 11 was delayed by 7 minutes when Pamjams Royal (5) refused to be loaded into the starting boxes and in doing so, dislodged its muzzle and the rug became detached. Stewards ordered that all greyhounds which were placed away be removed from the starting boxes due to this lengthy delay occurring. All greyhounds engaged in the race underwent a veterinary examination and were passed fit to start with no concerns raised by any trainers/handlers in the race. As a result of Pamjams Royal (5) refusing to load, Stewards instructed that this greyhound be loaded into the starting boxes first.

1 Mattapan	A post-race veterinary examination revealed nearside thigh abrasions with minor lacerations after the greyhound made contact with the running rail making the first turn. A 5-day incapacitation period was issued.
2 Boaz Elijah	Began extremely awkwardly and was very slow to begin.
5 Pamjams Royal	As the greyhound refused to load into the starting boxes which consequently delayed the start of the race, Stewards acting in accordance with GAR 106(2)(a) declared the greyhound 'hard to box'. Making the first turn was contacted on the hindquarters by another runner and lost ground before a short distance later was galloped on from behind and lost further ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lower back soreness. A 5-day incapacitation period was issued.
8 Prince Sal	A post-race urine sample was obtained.

Stewards have advised Mr Lord a veterinary certificate is required to verify the reasoning for the scratching of Goodbye Mate (4).</p> <p><u>Race 10:</u> Polly Wilson (2) (trainer Raymond Stevenson) - not cleared to race.</p> <p><u>Race 11:</u> Pamjams Royal (5) (trainer James Matthews) - 'Hard to Box' endorsement issued.</p> <p><u>Supplementary Report: Wentworth Park Friday 3 May 2024:</u> <u>Race 1:</u> At the direction of Stewards, kennel representative Jake White presented Bobby Ville (7) to the on-track veterinarian to verify the reasoning for the scratching whereby trainer Mr Wayne White had Will Ville (8) also engaged in the race which was drawn directly outside. A veterinary examination revealed a nearside fibula injury. A 21-day incapacitation period was issued. Stewards took no further action.</p>
