Thereafter, galloped awkwardly and finished a distant last. A post-race veterinary examination revealed offside shoulder soreness. A 10-day incapacitation period was issued.	
3 My Three Boys	Making the first turn was tightened for room and lost ground before a short distance later was galloped on from behind and lost momentum.	
5 Farmer Russell	Rounding the home turn raced greenly when colliding with ZEMANEK (8) multiple times before a short distance later galloped on heels and lost momentum.

Stewards had concerns with the greyhound's actions over the concluding stages of the race, however, after reviewing all available video footage, considering submissions made by Mr David Robertson and the veterinary report, Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied a breach of the rules had occurred. Notwithstanding this, Stewards advised Mr Robertson a warning would be placed on the greyhound's record.		
5 Springview Hawk	A pre-race urine sample was obtained. A post-race veterinary examination at the request of trainer Mr Jacob White revealed an abrasion with significant bruising to the offside metacarpal. A 5-day incapacitation period was issued.		
7 Zipping Striker	Making the first turn was tightened for room and lost ground. Rounding the home turn and making the turn into the front straight ran extremely wide and lost further ground.

A 21-day incapacitation period was issued. Stewards took no further action. Race 12: Te Hiko (1) (trainer David Robertson) - warning for its actions over the concluding stages. Supplementary Report: Richmond Monday 6 May 2024: Race 9: At the direction of Stewards, kennel representative Jake White presented Inner Light (1) to the on-track veterinarian to verify the reasoning for the scratching whereby trainer Mr Wayne White had Will Ville (2) also engaged in the race which was drawn directly outside. A veterinary examination revealed nearside hock soreness. A 10-day incapacitation period was issued. Stewards took no further action.
